Campus Placement Mission (CPM) and Jawahar Knowledge Centre (JKC):

Our Institution has been registered in 2005-2006 for Campus Placement Mission (CPM) under JKC (Jawahar Knowledge Centre) which is jointly launched by JNTU and IEG (Institute for Electronic Governance) to provide training and placements for students. From our institution, 16 students got placement in Sathyam and INFOSYS under this program in the year 2008-2009.

Yuva Nirman Training Programme:

Yuva Nirman training programmes was started in the institution, since 2007 in order to train and provide employment to unemployed youth.

94 students under 5 batches were trained and issued certificates and shown placement for the year 2008-2009

Sports Activities:

Competitions in sports and games were conducted for all years of B.Tech., MBA and MCA branches in cricket, shuttle, table tennis, badminton and Volleyball and prizes were distributed on the Sports Day conducted on 30th March 2009.
